



Fundraising Results are in!

When we mailed our fundraising letters on June 12, we initially hoped to raise at least \$50,000 starting with \$25,000 in pledges from Dave Holt, Amy Bell and Mike Woodin, the entire Hoffman board of directors, and an anonymous donor. These pledges could only be claimed if we received \$25,000 in matching donations. Well, you all really came through!

By the end of July, we received a total of \$52,580 in donations - many from individuals, several from businesses, and one grant from the Oregon Community Foundation. All in all - 114 donors gave \$72,580 including the original pledges. These donations make up for significant lost revenue and help the Hoffman explore and produce on-line content. Thus far our on-line classes in horticulture, writing, visual arts, and music appreciation have been very well received. We are making thoughtful adjustments in all of the programs to ensure we are serving our community through cultural exploration, creativity, and education. It may be some while before the center can return to what once was normal.
