In this workshop students will write short pieces from their lives using storytelling techniques to enliven specific moments that changed them. Students won't be writing anecdotes, the funny stories they may tell a friend over coffee, or a seatmate on a long flight. They will be writing the stories from their lives that haunt them, with joy, and sorrow, and growth. Finally, students will look at how to arrange these stamps from their lives into a longer narrative that tells their complex story.
