Letter from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

In 2024 I celebrated my third year at Hoffman, and Hoffman celebrated our 20th Anniversary as a dedicated nonprofit arts center in Manzanita. I love anniversaries because they allow one to reflect on the journey taken. They are also an invitation to look forward, to reconnect or reaffirm our purpose.

In preparation for this momentous anniversary I combed through a trove of Hoffman history, such as photos, letters, and newspaper clippings, covering the last two decades. **They painted a picture of a center that evolved over time alongside the needs of our community.** Over the years, volunteers explored different avenues, seeing what would stick, and through that process we developed our signature core programs. The freedom to explore and change is so important for strategic growth.

One of the new offerings we are excited about is youth programming. When we created our 2024-2026 Strategic Plan, we recognized that we are not serving our broader community if we are not serving youth. **Our Board and Staff committed to offering high quality, welcoming, creative opportunities for people of all ages.** We spent the last year talking with teachers, parents, and administrators to better understand the needs of this audience and best understand the gaps that need to be filled or

partnerships we can form. I'm thrilled to have ended the year with three youth workshops and to have laid out the plans for 2025, including youth art in the gallery each month, a Summer Art Camp in partnership with NCRD, workshops, and field trip opportunities.

Both our future and our past have at least one thing in common: the people. Our founders envisioned a participating community, and that vision has become a reality. In communities of our size, the actions of a small group often make the most change. Our success is thanks to so many people. Whether you have been with us since the beginning or you have just joined as a volunteer or donor, your support and input is invaluable. Thank you so much for another incredible year.

The love of our community has kept this center going for 20 years, and it will keep it going for many more.
